Introducción a las escalas: la escala de DO

Una escala musical son las 7 notas de una tonalidad ordenadas por grados conjuntos (notas sucesivas). Las escalas son una de las prácticas más convenientes para adquirir destreza con el instrumento.

Empezaremos practicando la escala de **DO mayor** que está formada por las 7 notas de esta tonalidad. Observa la imagen:
